## Food on Foot

Founded in 1996, **Food on Foot (FOF)** is a non-profit organization dedicated to providing the poor and homeless of Los Angeles with nutritious Sunday meals, clothing, job opportunities and assistance in the transition to employment and life off the streets.

Assistance facts from 2010:

- FOF distributed 13,495 meals, reaching more than 3,500 individuals.
- Of the 3,500 meals served, 52% were disabled and 20% were children.
- Approximately 50,000 personal items, including clothes, shoes, backpacks, toiletry items were distributed.
- 1,551 volunteers assisted in the Sunday program, including children and teens.

- FOF placed 242 men and women in the Work of Food Program

## Scott Newman Center

Actor and philanthropist Paul Newman and his family founded the **Scott Newman Center** in 1980 dedicated to providing life-affirming programs for disenfranchised children and their mothers who are recovering from abuse related to drug addiction or physical violence.

Over the last 20 years, the Center had developed innovative programs to combat drug and physical abuse and offer positive, life-changing instruction and mentoring to victims of this abuse.

In 1994, the Center created The Rowdy Ridge Gang Camp as a specialized summer program to specifically address the needs of children in Los Angeles County who have experienced abuse and neglect due to parental drug abuse and domestic violence and their mothers who have become alienated from their children due to these abuses.
