Founded in 1996, **People Helping People** is dedicated to reducing the number of children living in poverty by teaching low-income women, primarily single mothers, how to earn an adequate income through stable employment that pays a living wage.

The success of clients during the current economy has been hallmarked by their determination and willingness to strive for more. People Helping People program graduates report that 95% have maintained employment, 82% are employed full-time, 66% have been with the same employer for more than 2 years and 50% received at least one raise. Their success is a direct result of their ongoing efforts to provide a better future for themselves and their families.

One of our success stories, Crystal, a single mother of nine kids living in her car.

While enrolled in the Employment Program, she completed her GED, was hired by Kennecott Copper and has since more than doubled her income and is entirely self-sufficient. Crystal now serves as an ambassador for People Helping People.

Another graduate, Heidi entered the program living on welfare and raising her three children. Through hard work, she was hired by a banking call center and four years later has moved into sales and has more than tripled her income. Heidi serves as a mentor to other women.
