## Inside Out Community Arts

Founded in 1996, **Inside Out Community Arts** mission is to give youth from all backgrounds the tools, confidence and inspiration to make a positive difference in their communities and the world...from the inside out. Inside Out Community Arts program promotes healthy interaction among diverse at-risk and underserved middle and high school youth throughout Los Angeles.

Central to their mission is the commitment to foster understanding, respect and teamwork among diverse young people who otherwise have few or no guidance in positive conflict resolution.

The School Project (TSP) provides services to 100 students at four Los Angeles middle schools. A few of the activities include after-school and Saturday workshops, a day at the park, Theater Field Trips, and a 3-day camping retreat.

Youth are recommended by counselors and teachers because they need a safe haven to be able to express themselves freely. Youths graduate from this program with a broader view of themselves, and the world, increased cultural sensitive, new creative, social and conflict resolution skills and new friendships with students from across the city.

## OASIS West Los Angeles

**OASIS** is a non-profit educational organization dedicated to enriching the lives of mature adults, offering challenging educational programs in arts, humanities, social sciences, health, exercise, computers, volunteer service and many other areas. OASIS creates opportunities for older adults to continue their personal growth and serve their communities. Membership is free and open to all adults age 50 and over.

Of the many programs that foster this spirit of "giving back" is the Intergenerational Tutoring Program. This program is dedicated to improving students' reading ability, academic performance and attitudes about learning. The OASIS West Los Angeles Center opened in 1986 and coordinates nearly 300 classes a year across multiple sites.

They rely on volunteer instructors who are professionals of all ages who give their time to offer lectures and progress for our older adult audiences. Students in the tutoring program are often inspired to help their classmates.
