

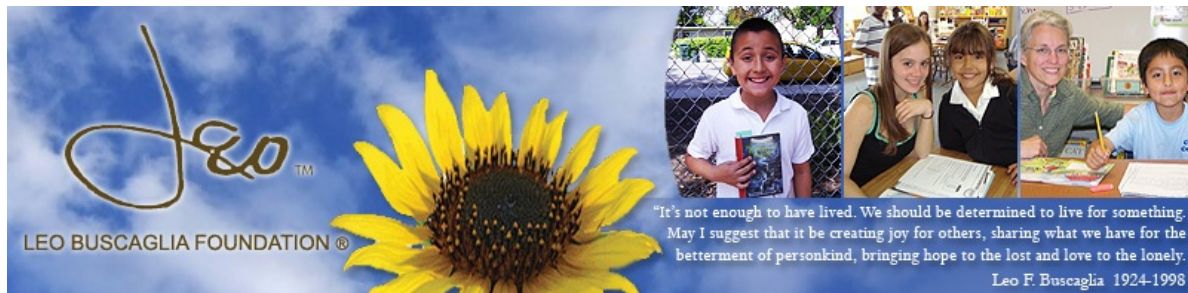

The Jester & Pharley Phund and the Reading Makes a Difference program have their origins in the acclaimed children's book "The Jester Has Lost His Jingle," written and illustrated by David Saltzman before his death from cancer in March 1990 at the age of 22.

Their mission is to inspire charity and empower children facing serious challenges - both educational and medical - by sharing the universal message of hope and caring through David's book.

The Jester & Pharley Phund received a grant to bring their Reading Makes a Difference program to two low-income schools in Southern California. The Reading Makes A Difference program inspires a love of reading among children from low-income families while helping them develop compassion for others.

The beauty of the Reading Makes A Difference program is that while trying to help other children, students develop a love of reading on their own. Schools praise the program for providing disadvantaged students with a tangible way to give.

The mission of **Caterina's Club** is 'providing food, support and shelter to homeless motel children.' They accomplish this through serving 1,000 low-income children every day at 10 different locations, spread throughout five Orange County cities, over a quarter million meals. Caterina's has also helped families get into an apartments and escape motel life by providing first and last month's rent with a security deposit.

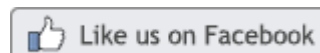
Caterina's Club received a grant to support their Feeding Kids in America programs and expand by partnering with additional after school programs to pilot new programs.
